Every year the World Health Organisation-Collaborating Centre for Cancer Education runs The International Summer School on Oncology for Medical Students.

The winning student will attend the International Summer School on Oncology for Medical Students in Vienna (10 - 19 July 2013). Cancer Council Australia will pay for registration, an economy class airfare, two weeks accommodation and living allowance (to a total of A\$8,000). ### Who should apply:

Any student currently enrolled in a medical course at an Australian University

### What to submit:

An essay – “**Cancer in General Practice**”  
Maximum length 2500 words.

Applicants may wish to focus on any aspect of cancer control.

The essays will be scored according to the following criteria

- Concise and logical presentation of the argument
- Relevance to cancer care in Australia
- Relevance to medical students
